

Australian vocational education and training statistics



Introduction

Information is presented for qualification completers at Community College Gippsland Ltd and is based on 50 responses.

Qualification completers are students who completed a training package qualification or an accredited qualification.

Highlights

Employment outcomes

Of qualification completers at Community College Gippsland Ltd:

- 48.4% had an improved employment status after training.
- 72.8% were employed after training. Of these, 73.8% received at least one job-related benefit.
- 70.3% were employed before training. Of these, 15.9% were employed at a higher skill level after training.
- 29.7% were not employed before training. Of these, 24.5% were employed after training.

Satisfaction with training

Of qualification completers at Community College Gippsland Ltd:

- 98.2% are satisfied with their training overall.
- 98.2% are likely to recommend their training provider.

Main reason for training decisions

Overall, 62.0*% of qualification completers undertook training for employment-related reasons.

Employment and further study outcomes

In 2025, 48.4*% of qualification completers had an improved employment status after training, similar to 2024.

72.8*% of qualification completers were employed after training. Of these:

- 73.8*% received at least one job-related benefit, similar to 2024.

70.3*% of qualification completers were employed before training. Of these:

- 15.9*% were employed at a higher skill level after training, similar to 2024.

29.7*% of qualification completers were not employed before training. Of these:

- 24.5*% were employed after training, similar to 2024.

Technical information

The sample for the National Student Outcomes Survey is selected from the National VET Provider and National VET in Schools collections. The response rate was 38.5% for qualification completers at Community College Gippsland Ltd.

Survey responses are weighted to population benchmarks from the national VET data collections. As the estimates from the National Student Outcomes Survey are based on information provided by a sample rather than on a population, they are subject to sampling variability; that is, they may differ from the statistics that would have been produced had all students been included and responded to the survey.

In this product we present margins of error. The margin of error is a measure of how much sampling variability there is. The smaller the margin of error, the more accurate the estimate. The margin of error is calculated such that there is a 95% chance that the estimate \pm margin of error contains the true value.
